

INFORMATION NOTICE ON DATA PROCESSING

Labomar S.p.A. (hereinafter referred to as the “Company”) issues this information notice pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter referred to as the “GDPR”), on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, in order to make you aware of the purposes and methods of the processing of personal data that you may communicate while browsing this website (hereinafter referred to as the “Website”). We must point out that this policy only refers to the Website and not to third-party websites which the User may connect to through the links available in the Website.

CATEGORIES OF DATA THAT MAY BE PROCESSED

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures in charge of the website’s operation acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data the transmission of which is implicit in the use of internet communication protocols. This information is not collected in order to be associated to identified data subjects, but due to its nature it may, by means of processing and integration with data held by third parties, allow users’ identification. This category includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by the users to connect to the website, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) form addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in reply, the numerical code indicating the status of the reply given by the server (done, error, etc.) and other parameters concerning the user’s operating system and computer environment. This data is used with the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information concerning the use of the site and to check its correct operation and it is deleted immediately after processing.

DATA VOLUNTARILY SUPPLIED BY THE USER

The optional, explicit and voluntary dispatching of electronic mail to the addresses indicated in the Website entails the subsequent acquisition of the sender’s address, necessary in order to reply to the requests, and also any other personal data contained in the message. Specific summary information is also given or displayed in the sections of the Website set up for particular on-demand services and subject, where appropriate, to the consent of the data subject.

COOKIES

In accordance with the Order of the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data No. 229 of 8 May 2014, on “Identification of simplified procedures for the provision of information and acquisition of consent for the use of cookies”, the Company informs users about the use of navigation cookies on this Website. We must point out that this policy only refers to the Website and not to third-party websites which the User may connect to through the links available in the Website.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small file that is sent to your browser and saved on your device when you visit a website such as Labomar.com. Cookies allow the Website to function efficiently and improve its performance, provide information to the Website owner for statistical or advertising purposes, mainly to personalise your browsing experience by remembering your preferences. The Website uses different types of first-party cookies (set up and managed by Labomar S.p.A. and third-party cookies (set up and managed by third parties on the basis of their own privacy policies and not under the control of Labomar S.p.A.): an explanatory table follows

TYPE OF COOKIE	FUNCTION
Technical cookies (browsing or session)	They ensure normal navigation and use of the website and are therefore aimed at making the same navigation within the site functional and optimised.
Functionality cookies	They are strictly necessary to provide services explicitly requested by the user.

First-party analytical cookies	They are used and created exclusively by Labomar S.p.A. to collect information, in aggregate and anonymous form, on the number of users and how users visit the site.
Third-party analytical cookies (e.g. Google Analytics)	Labomar S.p.A. has adopted appropriate tools to ensure that processing with these cookies is carried out for purely statistical purposes.

Enabling and disabling cookies from the browser.

Most browsers are configured to accept, control or possibly disable cookies via their settings. Please note, however, that disabling navigation or functional cookies may cause the site to function unsatisfactorily and/or limit the service we offer.

SCOPE OF DATA DISCLOSURE AND CATEGORIES OF RECIPIENTS

In order to be tasked with processing the data on behalf of the Company, those recipients will be appointed as data processors under a specific agreement or other legal document.

DATA SUBJECTS' RIGHTS

You have the right (see Articles 15 -22 of the GDPR) to ask our Company to have access to your personal data and to rectify them if they are inaccurate, to delete them or restrict their processing if the conditions are met, as well as to obtain portability of the data you have provided only if they are subject to automated processing based on consent or contract. Moreover, the Data Subject may withdraw his/her consent when this is necessary to pursue the processing purposes. In this case, however, the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. You also have the right to lodge a complaint before the competent supervisory authority for the protection of personal data, the Italian Data Protection Authority.
