WALTER BERTIN

Walter Bertin is the CEO and Founder of Labomar S.p.A., an Italian company operating internationally and specializing in the development and production of food supplements, medical devices, foods for special medical purposes, and cosmetics on behalf of third parties.

A third-generation pharmacist born in 1959 who has always been interested in the world of formulations and new discoveries, he founded Labomar in 1998, transforming what was a small galenic laboratory he owned by taking a huge gamble that later proved to be a winner.

Since 2023, he has been Vice Chairman in charge of ESG for Confindustria Veneto Est, an association created via the merger of Assindustria Venetocentro with Confindustria Venezia of the metropolitan area of Venice and Rovigo.

He was a board member of Federsalus from 2011 to 2018. He sat on the Board of Directors of Unindustria Treviso since 2012 and then Assindustria Venetocentro, of which he has been the Treviso area Delegate since 2018 and Vice Chairman in charge of the Environment and Sustainability since 2020.

He also served as the director of Federfarma from 1989 to 1992, helping to establish Farmarca, a consortium of pharmacies in the Province of Treviso, and served as its Chairman until 2004.
